Guest Speaker: Ps Greg Little from the Bunbury Aboriginal Evangelical Fellowship will be joining us <u>next Sunday</u>, July 18th, at our 9:30am service to share about God's work among our Australian indigenous people and also share from God's Word with us. Ps Greg is a highly respected Noongar Elder and has faithfully served in Christian leadership for many years, including 13 years as the pastor of Bunbury Aboriginal Evangelical Fellowship. He is also part of Global Mission Partners and Indigenous Ministries Australia (part of the missions' arm of Churches of Christ). Pastor Greg's message will be replayed at the 4:30pm service.

National Census: The next national census will be held on 10th August. The government uses the census as a guide for making decisions. "Church of Christ" was removed as an option under the "Religion" question in 1994. In order to increase the impact of any representations we choose to make as a church community to the government, you may like to consider registering your religion as "Church of Christ" on the upcoming census. Even though our allegiance to Jesus as Lord is what matters to God, sometimes the number of people registered as a single "denomination" can matter to our governing authorities.
